Personnel – General

CIVIL AIR PATROL UNIFORM MANUAL

CAPM 39-1, 15 March 2005, as changed 15 March 2006, is supplemented as follows:

1. Add to Ch 1, article 1-1: Each Cadet will receive a basic Air Force Blue uniform. BDU's will be purchased by the School. White Shirt and Dark Pants are appropriate until the uniform is received. Senior Members are only required to purchase uniforms and to wear them on missions and while flying corporate aircraft. However, they are highly encouraged to be in some sort of uniform. Female cadets that are not yet wearing a bra, will wear a V-neck white t-shirt with their Air Force Blues. Otherwise, they must wear a bra at all times.

2. Add to Ch 1, article 1-2: Uniform items issued by the Squadron will remain the property of the Squadron during the Cadet's first year of membership. If during this first year, the Cadet decides to leave the Civil Air Patrol or fails to renew, the uniform items will be returned to the Squadron for disposition. Items deemed unserviceable will be disposed of. The Squadron will maintain a log of items issued to each Cadet. Each Cadet will sign this log sheet upon issuance of items.

3. Add to Ch 1, article 1-5c: Exercise clothing will consist of the following:

- a. White, crew cut t-shirt
- b. Blue shorts
- c. White socks
- d. Athletic shoes
- e. Squadron ball cap – Ball cap will not be worn during athletic events or exercise. It will only be worn while in an opening formation or during a fund raiser requiring exercise clothing, such as a car wash.

This clothing will be worn during the Cadet Physical Fitness testing and at other times as specified by the Squadron Commander.

The shorts will be plain, with no markings on them. They will fit loosely around the Cadet. No skin-tight shorts will be allowed.

4. Add to Ch 2, article 2-1f: Members are authorized to wear a black ball cap with "801" in red lettering embroidered on the front while in the Air Force style BDU and the CAP Blue Utility uniforms. Senior members with rank and cadet officers may wear large metal rank insignia centered in the "0". Red ball caps with "Huron Cadet Squadron" embroidered on the cap may be worn until a black ball cap is issued to the member.

5. Add to Ch 2, article 2-1g: Cadets will be issued a squadron patch. Senior members may purchase a squadron patch for wear on their uniform. Patch is to be worn in accordance with CAPM 39-1.

6. Add to Ch 5, article 5-5: The following shoulder cords are approved for wear during Huron Cadet Squadron functions: Except as indicated, they may not be worn during Group, Wing, or National sponsored functions. Wear will be in accordance with CAPR 39-1.

Color	Designation for Wear
Green	Squadron Cadet Advisory Council Representative to Group CAC
White	Color Guard members

- Both the green and white cords may be worn to all Civil Air Patrol events.

Maroon/Gold	Squadron Cadet NCO of the Year
Maroon/White	Squadron Cadet NCO of the Quarter
Blue/Gold	Squadron Cadet Honor Society

7. Precedence of Cords. If a cadet is authorized more than one cord, they shall wear the most senior cord. The following table lists order of precedence:

Squadron CAC Member
Squadron Color Guard Member
Squadron Cadet NCO of the Year
Squadron Cadet NCO of the Quarter
Squadron Cadet Honor Society

8. Term of Wear.

Squadron CAC Member	While assigned to the Group CAC.
Squadron Color Guard Member	While assigned to the Squadron Color Guard.
Squadron Cadet NCO of the Year	1 January to 31 December.
Squadron Cadet NCO of the Quarter	During the quarter immediately following selection.
Squadron Cadet Honor Society	While a member of the Cadet Honor Society.
