CAP EMERGENCY SERVICES TRAINING AND OPERATIONAL MISSIONS

CAPR 60-3, 26 May 2004, is supplemented as follows:

HURON CADET SQUADRON

SEARCH AND RESCUE OPERATIONS PLAN: (ADDED)

a. Purpose. To set forth policy for Emergency Services operations.

b. Plan. Cadet members of the Huron Cadet Squadron will not take part in actual missions. Senior members are free to participate and must ensure all required documents are completed. Training will be given to cadets and all members are authorized to participate in search and rescue training missions in order to complete requirements for a SQTR.

c. Action. The Emergency Services Officer (ESO) will be responsible for the following:

(1.) Ensuring all unit members complete the General Emergency Services requirements. These include:

- a) Operations Security Awareness training.
- b) CAPT 116, both parts.
- c) CAPT 117, all three parts.

(2.) Coordinating training activities with the Group ESO.

(3.) Assignment of ground team gear to cadets. Each cadet will receive the following items:

- a) Green pistol belt.
- b) Canteen and pouch.
- c) First Aid kit.
- d) Orange vest.

These items remain the property of the Huron Cadet Squadron.

(4.) In association with the Personnel Officer, the ESO will maintain records of ES qualifications for all unit members.

d. Operational Contacts. This squadron does not maintain any contacts with outside agencies in regards to operational missions.
