MISHAP REPORTING AND INVESTIGATIONS

SUMMARY OF CHANGES

Updated contact information for CAWG/CC, CAWG/SE, CAWG/CV, and Squadron Safety Officer.

CAPR 62-2, 8 November 2002, as changed 22 April 2005, is supplemented as follows:

SQ. 801 Mishap Notification.

HQ SQ 801 must be notified immediately in the event of any mishap involving SQ 801 personnel or equipment. Anyone having knowledge of such an event should immediately:

A) Notify the Squadron Commander, Squadron Safety Officer, or Squadron Deputy Commander:

B) After calling HQ 801, immediately call HQ CAWG in the order listed until one person is reached (CAPR 62-2, CAWG Supplement 1, paragraph 4f dated 29 March 2007):

Notification Notice. The above notice by the individual involved in the mishap or witnessing the mishap does not replace the notification requirement by the Squadron Commander required under paragraph 4a. The Squadron Commander or Deputy Commander shall immediately notify CAWG and the Group 6 Commander of all known facts and circumstances.

Notice Restrictions. Notifications shall only be by telephone. Do not use radio or other like means IAW CAPR 62-2, CAWG Supplement 1, paragraph 4h.

Minor Mishap Investigations. The Squadron Commander shall assign the investigator for minor mishap investigations. The assigned investigator shall complete the investigation and document it on a CAPF 78. The investigator can not be directly involved with the activity or be the project officer of the activity. The Squadron Safety Officer shall conduct all follow-ups to the initial investigations, or as may be assigned IAW CAPR 62-2 dated 8 November 2002.
