**CIVIL AIR PATROL PROPERTY REGULATION**

CAPR 67-1, 15 November 2005, is supplemented as follows:

**1-1. Property Relationships.**

a. **ADDED.** All equipment and possessions are purchased by the Coalinga-Huron Unified School District and remains the property of the purchaser. This unit will not own any Civil Air Patrol equipment or property. Communications equipment that may be assigned to the unit, will be the property of the Civil Air Patrol and all elements of CAPR 100-2 remain in effect.

**a. Purpose.** To ensure the Huron Cadet Squadron is ready for the Group Inspector General's visit.

**b. Action:** The Personnel Officer will act as the unit's Inspector General. This individual will ensure that all parts of the Self-Assessment Tool are completed by the specific officers and maintained through-out the year. The DP will also ensure this tool is reviewed by the Sq/CC and submitted to the Group Administrative Officer when required.
