GRADE POINT AVERAGE AND ATTENDANCE

HURON CADET SQUADRON

POLICY ON GRADE POINT AVERAGE AND SCHOOL ATTENDANCE:

- a. **Purpose.** To set forth policy for Cadet participation based on school records.
- b. **Background.** Each Cadet must attend school regularly and maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.0. It is the goal of this unit to strive for high academic excellence in the lives of its Cadets.
- c. **Action.** The Cadet Programs Officer will be responsible for the following:
 - (1.) Reviewing Progress Reports and Reports Cards as they are sent home.
 - a) Students with a GPA above 2.5 may hold any Cadet Staff position they are qualified to hold.
 - b) Students with a GPA between 2.0 and 2.5 will be removed from their Cadet Staff position. This is not a punishment, but a way to give the Cadet more time to concentrate on educational issues.
 - c) Students with a GPA below 2.0 will not be allowed to participate in any Civil Air Patrol activity, until they can show documented evidence that their GPA has risen to a minimum of 2.0. However, they may set up a tutoring schedule with the Cadet Programs Officer.
- d. **Tutoring.** The senior members are not teachers or certified tutors. However, in an effort to provide assistance to our Cadets, the Cadet Programs Officer will strive to provide a tutor to any Cadet that requests it. The tutor may be a senior member with an expertise in a subject area, or may be arranged through the Huron Middle School. Senior members may tutor during regular meetings if they wish.
